Thank you all for your wonderful partnership this week during parent-teacher conferences. It is so important for us to build a strong, positive home-school relationship to ensure all students are reaching their full potential.

In November, our St. Perpetua community has the honor to team up with Winter Nights to provide safe and warm nightly shelter to homeless families with children in the Community Center, November 6th-20th. Winter Nights is a Contra Costa based program whose mission is to help participating families achieve self-sufficiency and ultimately stable housing. It is exciting and special that St. Perpetua parishioners and school families can affect a widespread crisis while giving right here at home. Thank you to many who have already expressed interest in helping!

The school is assigned Saturday, November 11th to provide all meals and services and we need your help to make this a success!

- <u>BEFORE SIGNING-UP</u> for one of the many opportunities, <u>please watch this</u> <u>informational video</u> about the different volunteer opportunities being offered. Parents and students are both welcome to volunteer during our designated day and both may receive volunteer hours and service hours respectively.
- **DONATE ITEMS** If you are unable to volunteer, we have been provided a list of donations that are needed for the families. You may sign-up to bring something from the list on the **Sign-Up Genius**. All donations are due before or on *Saturday, November 4th*.
- IMPORTANT FOR FOOD PREP AND SERVICE If you are hoping to prepare or serve food during Winter Nights at St. P's, thank you! Since our beautiful new commercial kitchen is now subject to insurance and county health guidelines and inspection, we wanted all to know up front that anyone planning to prepare and/or serve a meal will be required to obtain and present a Food Handler Certificate prior to volunteering. The course is available online for \$6.95 at this link and the cost is reimbursable upon request. A copy of your certificate will be collected and kept at St. P's. Food Handler Certificates are valid for three (3) years.
