Building Empathy is a Lifetime Practice

This month, many of our SEL lessons focused on the topic of empathy. The ability to understand how others feel has many lifetime gifts for everyone

involved. For one, practicing empathy can help us understand people better & work better with them in all areas of life, and build POSITIVE relationships. Empathy is a response based on heartfelt genuine concern for others. To show empathy, we need to first notice and understand how others feel followed by caring and showing support. So how do we build and practice this skill?

There are many ways but I want to highlight one of the most powerful methods to practice this skill is to reflect on these key questions when noticing someone who is experiencing difficulty for any reason: 1. What is this person feeling? 2. How would I feel if I were in their shoes? And 3. What can I do to be supportive? Remember, empathy is an emotional superpower that is built over time so start practicing it daily and you can make the world a better place and contribute to your ongoing success in all areas of your life.
