Weekly Update from Mrs. Gotchet

Tomorrow is our disaster drill! Please make sure to <u>watch this video</u> for a breakdown of the entire day. Below are key reminders:

- Pick-up begins at 11:30am.
- Please do not come to campus before 11:10am.
- Upon arrival, parents make their way to the school plaza by the flagpole to complete Emergency Dismissal Form - parents must have their ID in order to pick up their children
 - If a parent is picking up other students who are not their children, they MUST be listed on that child's emergency contact form prior to the drill
- Once the form is completed, parents are to walk around the *front of the school building* to the cafe doors to retrieve their children.
- Jr. High cell phones will be available for pick-up at the cafe doors.
- Students are to pick-up their backpack after they are picked up by their parents.
- Backpacks are located in the following areas:
 - TK & K backpacks lined up on the benches students sit on during morning carpool
 - 1st & 2nd grade outside 2nd grade classroom 1st grade backpacks lined up on the ground
 - 3rd & 4th grade outside 4th grade classroom 3rd grade backpacks lined up on the ground
 - 6th & 7th grade outside the downstairs 6th grade classroom lined up on the ground
 - 5th & 8th grade outside the 8th grade classroom 5th grade backpacks lined up on the ground
- ALL students must be picked up by 12pm.
- There is NO Cub House or Panther House.
- · Please be patient.




Save The Date - Wednesday, November 29th


