each age group and supplemental worksheets will be sent home so that the message can be reinforced. Introducing the students to coping tools will empower them and teach them self-regulation, an invaluable tool in our world of increasing noise and stimulation. Depending on a child's temperament, his/her coping skills can be very different. Whereas one person calms down through stillness and meditation, another could feel centered through movement. Thus, students are given worksheets with a variety of coping skills and strategies so that they can choose what works best for them. However, despite these differences, breathing techniques are one universal way of managing and regulating our nervous systems. As such this year, breathing exercises and methods, particularly the diaphragmatic deep belly breathing have been emphasized in TK through 8th grade classes. Other coping tools include but are not limited to talking to trusted adults and friends, taking healthy space, drinking water, exercise and movement, reading a book, listening to music, art and creative endeavors, journaling, counting while breathing, nature time, doing a joyous activity, remembering happy memories, etc.


